Scientific importance	
<p>The goal of my research is to find opportunities of housing for citizens of Ostrava city who have physical or combination disability and identify possible problems with obtaining or keeping compliant housing up for them.</p>	
Practical relevance	
<p>Some of the scientific studies are focusing on elimination of social exclusion or poverty and finding quality of social services and the others preventive and supported measures. These findings are made in connection with needs of treated people. Among members of social groups which are treated with exclusion or her extreme form (homelessness) are people with disability. I want to focusing my attention on evaluation of housing conditions (which disabled people have). The reason is that could be very important factor which influences their full integration to society.</p>	
Main thesis	
<p>The housing is generally one of the basic human rights. My aim is to understand how people with disability live and which type of housing they prefer. The meaning of home could be explained through three domains (social, spatial and legal) by authors Etgar and Meert. The possibility of obtaining and keeping housing up (and possible problems with it) could be influenced with the other key factors (opportunities on a labor market, exiting system of support, legislation).</p>
