Resumen. Abstract. The 20th Anniversary of Hispanic Studies in Ostrava. 1993–2013. The contribution remembers the 20th anniversary of the foundation of the Sub-department of Spanish Studies at the Department of Romance Studies, a component of the Faculty of Arts of the University of Ostrava. The author outlines the history of Hispanic Studies in Ostrava. Then she presents the research and pedagogical activities of the Sub-department of Spanish Studies and summarizes the cooperation with the embassies of Hispanophone countries in the Czech Republic and with the Association of Spanish Teachers. She mentions the most important events held during the past twenty years, emphasizes the participation in Erasmus Students and Teachers Mobility, which is an important part of studies, and presents the range of degree programmes and degrees taught by the Sub-department. She also refers to the articles, papers and information articles on Hispanic Studies in Ostrava which have been published in both national and foreign journals and monographs.
