Andrea Pokorná: PhD, Full Professor of Nursing and Head of the Department of Health Sciences, vice-dean for non-medical study programmes and information technologies, Masaryk University (Faculty of Medicine), Czech Republic. She is a vice-chairman of the Association of University Educators of Non-Medical Health Professions in the Czech Republic (bringing together 24 higher education institutions). She is also closely collaborating with the Ministry of Health to support the academic education of allied healthcare professionals. Her research activities are focused mostly on Nursing education and its determiners, Quality of care and Adverse events, Patient Safety, Missed Nursing Care and wound care, with special attention to Pressure ulcers. She has been elected the president of the European Pressure Ulcer Advisory Panel (for 2023-2025). She serves as Scientific Recorder of EWMA (2023-2025). She is an author and co-author of over 100 indexed publications with over 800 citations. She is a co-author for developing the physician's curriculum and the Levels 4-7 nursing curricula in wound management.
