PRACTICAL INFORMATION

COST OF LIVING	<p>Students ought to have between 5,700-11,500 CZK (225-450€) per month. The recommended amount is 400€ per month. Tuition fees are waived for all Erasmus+ students, however all students must pay some fees.</p>
ACCOMMODATION	<p>Student housing is available in our Halls of Residence or by private let. Prices can range from approx. 90€ for triple occupancy, 100€ for a double and 120€ for a single (prices include energy and services). See below for more housing options.</p>
MEALS	<p>Subsidized student meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) are available at the two restaurants within the Kampus Palace building in the center of Ostrava: Black Kale - Raw&Vegan or Guest Restaurant. Meals are ordered with the University Student ID card and must be charged with adequate funds. Subsidized lunches are available at the macrobiotic restaurant Slunečnice. Meals cost between 3-5€.</p>
HEALTH INSURANCE	<p>Each student is responsible for purchasing health insurance for the entire stay in the Czech Republic. Students who are citizens of the European Union, Switzerland, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein should ask their home insurance company to provide them with the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), which entitles to essential healthcare. It is highly recommended to arrange additional commercial insurance. Others should purchase appropriate insurance.</p>
VISA INFORMATION	<p>Visa information can be found at the following link: www.mvcr.cz/mvcren/article/information-for-schools-and-students.aspx</p> <p>For non-EU citizens there are two options to enter the Czech Republic. If possible, students may enter Europe with the 90-day Schengen visa. Although the semester is slightly more than 90 days, our professors are accustomed to working with international students within this timeframe (i.e. scheduling exams early). If you wish to obtain a visa, the Czech Foreign Ministry suggests a Long-Term Visa for stays more than 90 days and less than one year (i.e. an exchange student).</p> <p>It is your responsibility to consult with the Czech Embassy on your visa options. Please note, the long-term visa process can take more than 2 months.</p>

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CLUB	<p>Our international student club is known as the Erasmus Student Network (ESN Ostravská). The club is operated by student volunteers and is open to all international students. Each semester they organize events and outings for international students. Rooms are offered in single, double and triple occupancy. There is a common bathroom and kitchen facility.

All international students stay here; housing students from Portugal to Poland and Mexico to South Korea. As a university operated dorm they are inexpensive and with standard dormitory amenities. Students who are not staying for the summer semester are supposed to leave the dormitories no later than 31 January of the given year.
